I am pleased to brief you about the progress of “RES Heating and Cooling – Strategic Actions Development” (RES H/C SPREAD) project, dedicated to the development of pilot regional plans for heating and cooling from renewable energy, as well as to the replication of the good planning practices to other regions.

The plans of the six pilot regions have been completed and the relevant regional authorities have committed to their implementation. During the last months we assessed the experience gained and derived conclusions and recommendations to help planners.
